LOS ANGELES, April 2, 2015 — It's all aboard for the [Art Directors Guild \(ADG, IATSE Local 800\)](#) at the [22nd Annual Santa Clarita Cowboy Festival](#), taking place the weekend of April 18 and 19. Participating for the fourth year but at a new venue at the William S. Hart Park, Newhall, the ADG booth is located at the Heritage Junction train station.

On Saturday three Guild artists will be drawing caricatures of children and families and on the following day two models in period costume will be posing for artists young and old. Original art, memorabilia, props and final set photos from western-themed movies and television shows, in addition to personal western art by Production Designers, Illustrators and other Guild members, will be on display at the ADG's Cowboy Art Gallery.

There will be much to see at the event with 15 bands performing on four stages, a barnyard animal area and a trail to the Hart Mansion, the retirement home of silent cowboy movie star, William S. Hart.

Guild President Mimi Gramatky said, "The Cowboy Festival is a highlight of the Guild's year with a chance for members to share their work with their families. We are excited to be at this historic venue for the first time."
